How to use this guide

This guide presents and defines the mineralogy and healing effects of crystals in common use. It offers brief information on the basic properties of the crystals. For further information, consult the indicated bibliography as needed. Terms used in the guide are explained in detail as follows:

Title: the title of each entry gives the name or names of the illustrated crystal. In addition to mineralogical names, their common names are also used if they better pinpoint or describe the crystal in question. To distinguish the mineralogical names, which are scientifically recognised, from the common, or trade, names, they are printed in black, while the common names are printed in blue. In certain cases the blue names are chosen titles which serve as a suggestion, to both gemstone dealers and interested readers, of correct and clear designation of the crystals, including their healing properties.

Mineralogy: this gives brief information on the mineralogy, especially the crystal classification and group where necessary, as well as the crystalline structure and nature of formation ('primary' = molten magma formation, 'secondary' = formation through disintegration and deposits, 'tertiary' = metamorphic formation under heat and pressure). In addition to the visible colour, these details are very important for the healing effect and usage of a crystal. Their significance can be found in Michael Gienger's book *Crystal Power, Crystal Healing* (Cassell London 1998).

Indications: this gives information on the important healing effects and areas of activity of respective crystals. It particularly presents those major properties that characterise the crystal in question and distinguish it from crystals with similar properties. Other healing effects can be looked up in the indicated bibliography.

(**SP**) refers to the 'spirit or spiritual aspect', the innate nature of a person including his or her important intentions, aims and focus in life; (**S**) refers to the 'soul or the subconscious', including temperament, emotions, intuitive perceptions, dreams, psychological experiences, habits and unconscious reactions; (**M**) refers to 'mind or mental aspects', including ideas, values, convictions, views as well as the manner of thinking and conscious action; (**B**) refers to the 'body or physical aspect', the human organism as a whole with its senses, organs and functions.

Defining these four aspects clearly differentiates what can be influenced, enhanced, changed or cured with the help of the crystals.

Bib.: this information refers to comprehensive literature in which the crystal in question, or at least crystals of the same kind or family, are described. The numbers 1 to 4 refer to the bibliography on page 95.

Rarity: this gives an estimate of the availability of the crystal in question. Naturally this is often prone to a lot of variation depending on which crystals are collected or mined in which mines or discovery sites at each point in time. As a result these estimates are never 'absolute'! They are only intended to give a clue as to the chances of finding a desired crystal in the shops in the foreseeable future. Also the availability of a crystal does not always have to do with how rare or common it is. Rare crystals that are well known are sometimes more available than more common but less known ones. The availability has been individually classified as follows:

Common: means it has been continuously available in large quantities over a long period of time and cut into different forms and shapes. No scarcity of the common shapes or forms is anticipated in the foreseeable future.

Readily available: means sufficiently available most times. No major scarcities of particular forms are expected in the future.

Not always available: means not always obtainable. Sometimes there is a scarcity or just a few forms are available in limited quantities. The reserves are unsteady or limited.

Scarce: means hardly available. There is a frequent scarcity over long periods of time. It is sometimes only available in very few forms. Reserves are very limited.

Rare: means extremely scarce and obtainable only at definite times. For such crystals there is only a minimal reserve, or the known discovery sites are already completely exhausted or no longer accessible.

○ This little tick box enables you to make a note of the crystals you have – giving you an overview of crystals in your collection, first aid kit, experiment kit or therapy repertoire.



Abalone (Paua shell, Mother-of-pearl)

Mineralogy: coloured shell (Aragonite, orthorhombic, secondary)

Indications: (SP) cheerfulness, security, protection (S) helps overcome despondency, insecurity and disappointment (M) ensures careful dealing with oneself and others (B) ameliorates irritation and inflammations of skin, mucous membrane and sensory organs.

Rarity: common ○



Actinolite

Mineralogy: chain silicate of the Amphibole group (monocl., tert.)

Indications: (SP) straightforwardness, new orientation, determination (S) promotes self-esteem and inner balance (M) helps pursue personal aims appropriately (B) stimulates activities of the liver and kidney as well as all building-up and growth processes.

Actinolite with Chlorite

Mineralogy: chain silicate rich in minerals (monoclinic, tertiary)

Indications: (SP) success through calm tenacity (S) brings patience, perseverance and self-confidence (M) makes decision-making easier (B) stimulates activities of the liver and kidneys as well as all fortifying and growth processes of the body.

Actinolite Quartz

Mineralogy: actinolite in quartz crystal (monoclinic/trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) new orientation, awareness, course correction (S) enhances sense of right timing (M) aids in overcoming weaknesses and mistakes (B) stimulates the liver and kidneys as well as metabolism; detoxification and excretion.

Aegirine

Mineralogy: chain silicate of the pyroxene group (monocl., prim.)

Indications: (SP) sincerity, virtue (S) promotes self-respect, helpful with relationship problems, separation or grief (M) focusing on major goals (B) good for backaches and pains, for nerves, muscles, bones and hormonal glands.

Rarity: scarce ○

Aegirine-Augite

Mineralogy: chain silicate of the pyroxene group (monocl., prim.)

Indications: (SP) posture; perseverance (S) encourages patience, helps maintain composure in difficult situations (M) for work requiring patience (B) enhances digestion, activities of the intestine, kidneys as well as that of the hormonal glands; ameliorates pain.

Rarity: scarce ○



Agate

Mineralogy: banded quartz (silicon dioxide, trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) inner stability, composure, maturity (S) protection, warmth, security, self-confidence (M) sense of reality, pragmatic thinking (B) for the eyes, hollow organs (like the stomach, intestines etc.), blood vessels and skin. Protective stone during pregnancy.

Agate 'with cell-like markings'

Mineralogy: agate with cell/tissue type signs (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) versatility, regeneration (S) revives dazed frame of mind (M) enhances concentration on the essential (B) for tissues, metabolism, immune system; good for infections and skin diseases.

Rarity: not always available ○



Agate 'Dendritic Agate'

Mineralogy: agate with fern-like manganese markings (trig., prim.)

Indications: (SP) integrity, purification (S) helps overcome emotional boundary violations and emotional strain (M) lends ability to examine and resolve unpleasant issues (B) for tissue detoxification in problems of the skin, mucous membrane, lungs and intestine.

Agate 'Eye Agate'

Mineralogy: agate with eye-shaped markings (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) interest, resistance, protection (S) perseverance, also in the face of nightmares (M) helps face facts (B) for inflammation of the eyes, problems of the conjunctiva or retina, glaucoma, blood vessels and prostate.

Agate 'Fire Agate'

Mineralogy: agate with iridescent hematite layers (trigonal, primary)
Indications: (SP) initiative, commitment (S) cheerfulness, contentment (M) vigour, positive thinking, understanding experiences (B) for excretion, problems of the intestine, especially flatulence, diarrhoea, constipation, (chronic) inflammation.

Agate 'with bladder-like markings', 'Fortification Agate'

Mineralogy: agate with bladder-like markings (trigonal, primary)
Indications: (SP) self control, letting go, inner calm (S) setting bounds, relaxation (M) helps to resolutely implement one's ideas or projects (B) for bladder problems, especially infections, urinary retention, incontinence and prostate.

Agate 'with inflammation markings'

Mineralogy: agate with natural pink colour (trigonal, primary)
Indications: (SP) transformation, consolation, appeasement (S) renewed confidence in unpleasant situations (M) careful mastering of difficulties (B) for inflammation of all organs or tissues; enhances perspiration during fever.

Agate 'Lace Agate', 'Crazy Lace'

Mineralogy: agate with twisting & turning bands (trigonal, primary)
Indications: (SP) elegance, mental agility, dynamism (S) liveliness, variety (M) flexibility in thinking and acting (B) promotes tissue metabolism, very effective against infections, insect bites, varicose veins and haemorrhoids.

Agate 'Layered Agate', 'Banded Agate'

Mineralogy: agate with band-like layers (trigonal, primary)
Indications: (SP) steadfastness and unity (S) protection, security, moral stability (M) for pragmatic planning in thinking and actions (B) for the intestine and digestion; improves elasticity of blood vessel walls and prevents varicose veins.

Agate, pink 'Apricot Agate'

Mineralogy: agate, predominantly pink coloured (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) incentive, compassion (S) steadfastness, protection and safety (M) helps to actively deal with difficult assignments (B) for inflammation; activates absorption of nutrients in the intestine and also stimulates metabolism and blood circulation.

Agate, red 'Blood Agate'

Mineralogy: agate with a natural red colour (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) strength, stability, increases stamina (S) perseverance and strength generated from inner balance (M) development and conscious usage of personal abilities (B) fortifies stomach, intestine and blood vessels, enhances circulation and blood-flow.

Agate 'with scar images'

Mineralogy: agate with scar-like images (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) amendment, eases burdens (S) overcome past injuries (M) helps to actively cope with stress and strain (B) improves skin and tissue metabolism, enhances wound healing, and reduces scar formation.

Agate 'with skin-like image'

Mineralogy: agate, similar to layers of the skin (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) contact, setting bounds (S) stability and perseverance (M) constructive reflection (B) regulates, builds up, detoxifies the skin, for rashes, inflammations, fungal infections, as well as dry, chapped or impure skin.

Agate 'Snakeskin Agate'

Mineralogy: agate, similar to the skin of a snake (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) clarification, communication (S) calms agitated emotions (M) for realistic thinking and well-considered actions (B) good for the brain, metabolism, lymph and body fluids, decongests mucous and ameliorates allergies.

Agate 'Star Agate', 'Thunderegg', 'Amulet stone'

Mineralogy: agate in a rhyolite or porphyry nodule (trig., prim.)

Indications: (SP) consciousness, alertness, maturity (S) good perceptive faculty in a state of inner stability; reduces stress (M) for good understanding and promotes inference skills (B) for the brain, spinal cord, nerves, liver, immune system and hormone balance.

Agate 'with stomach-like markings'

Mineralogy: agate with stomach like markings (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) life experience, work (S) enhances absorption of impressions and experiences (M) promotes learning and sober reflection (B) for digestion and metabolism, for stomach and intestine problems e.g. nausea or gastritis.

Agate 'Tubular Agate'

Mineralogy: agate with tube-like inclusions (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) unfolding, progress (S) tenacity, acceptance of the inevitable (M) insight, reconsider views (B) promotes activity of the glands and metabolism; very effective for prostate, bladder and digestive problems; aids sexual endeavours.

Agate 'with uterus-shaped markings'

Mineralogy: agate, with uterus-shaped markings (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) growth, development, blossom (S) instils deep security when homesick or lonely (M) cautiousness (B) for inflammation of the uterus, menstrual pain, pregnancy and normalisation after childbirth.

Agate 'Water Agate', 'Enhydro'

Mineralogy: agate nodule filled with water (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) growth, protection, development (S) instils deep security and enhances inner peace, promotes empathy (M) fortifies solicitude and openness (B) protective stone in pregnancy; regulates water and hormone balance.

Rarity: scarce ○

Agate, white 'Peace Agate'

Mineralogy: colourless, white agate (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) calm, peace, self-confidence (S), strengthens inner composure, for kindness, sincerity and light-heartedness (M) promotes tolerance and understanding (B) for the eyes, brain, skin, lymph and tissues; protective stone in pregnancy.

Agate, white/black 'Zebra Agate'

Mineralogy: agate with black/white stripes (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) reformation, reflection, maturity (S) promotes objectivity and straightforwardness (M) enhances meticulousness; for objective and rational ordering of one's life (B) improves activities of motor nerves, sense of hearing and balance.

Agatised Coral

Mineralogy: fossilised corals (lime or quartz, trigonal, secondary)

Indications: (SP) self-expression; hospitality (S) eases fear as well as emotional and social strain (M) promotes ability to communicate, team spirit and synergy in partnership (B) helps with breathing difficulties, cramped bronchial tubes and cough.

Rarity: scarce ○



Alabaster (Gypsum)

Mineralogy: fine crystalline calcium sulphate (monocl., second.)

Indications: (SP) stability, self-control, setting bounds (S) helps set boundaries and stabilise labile psychic state, protects in cases of hypersensitivity (M) conscious recognition of old patterns (B) firms up tissues, loosens up hardened muscles (for short-term use only).

Alabaster Engelberg (Gypsum)

Mineralogy: alabaster nodule from Leonberg (monocl., second)

Indications: (SP) self-awareness, setting bounds (S) for calm and relaxation, helps overcome old habits, intensifies dreams (M) helps place priorities (B) for restful sleep, improves well-being, alleviates pain and releases tension.

Rarity: scarce ○



Albite (Feldspar)

Mineralogy: sodium feldspar (lattice silicate, triclinic, primary)

Indications: (SP) intuitive perception, broadens horizons (S) brings relief, opening and broad vision (M) improves perceptive faculty, helps recognise new perspectives in life (B) for flexible muscles, pliable tissues and healthy skin.

Alexandrite (Chrysoberyl)

Mineralogy: colour changing chrysoberyl (orthorhombic, tertiary)

Indications: (SP) inspiration and willpower (S) intensifies dreams and perception of emotions (M) promotes power of imagination, willingness to take risks and perception of inner voice (B) for disorders of the nerves and senses; helps with inflammations, stimulates the liver.

Alunite (Alumstone)

Mineralogy: alkaline potassium aluminium sulphate (trig., tert.)

Indications: (SP) comfort, modesty (S) settles discords, disperses fear and guilty conscience (M) encourages frugality and being reserved (B) helps in cases of inflammations, eczema and rashes as well as radiation damage.

Amazonite (Feldspar)

Mineralogy: potassium feldspar (lattice silicate, triclinic, prim./tert.)

Indications: (SP) self-determination (S) emotional balance (M) harmonious interaction of intellect and intuition (B) regulates metabolic disorders (liver); harmonises the brain, vegetative nervous system, internal organs; facilitates childbirth.

Amber

Mineralogy: fossiliferous resin (organic, amorphous, secondary)

Indications: (SP) makes carefree (S) for cheerfulness and trust (M) strengthens belief in oneself (B) good for the stomach, spleen, gall-bladder, liver, joints, skin, mucous membranes, glands and intestine; aids teething in children; helps with allergies, rheumatism and diabetes.

Rarity: common ○



Amethyst Quartz 'Chevron Amethyst'

Mineralogy: violet/white striped crystal quartz (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) sobriety, purity, composure, calm (S) peeps up in cases of perpetual tiredness, resolves persistent anxiety (M) helps overcome habitual tendencies and addictions (B) good for the lungs, large intestine and skin; alleviates itching and sunburn.

Amethyst with Chalcedony (Quartz)

Mineralogy: amethyst with chalcedony stripes (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) reconciliation, peace, kindness (S) promotes feelings of happiness and universal love (M) helps with self-reconciliation and reconciliation among people (B) cleanses the body fluids and harmonises the whole organism.

Rarity: scarce ○



Amethyst, dark purple (Quartz)

Mineralogy: very deep violet crystal quartz (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) uprightness, impartiality (S) willpower, helps overcome pain, grief and losses (M) improves concentration, helps ward off external influences (B) alleviates pain, bruises and swellings; good for diarrhoea.

Rarity: scarce ○



Amethyst, light purple 'Cape Amethyst' (Quartz)

Mineralogy: light violet crystal quartz (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) peace, spirituality, clarification, meditation (S) for intuition, good clear dreams, improves fitful sleep (M) enhances conscious perception and understanding experiences (B) good for headaches, the lungs, skin and nerves.

Amethyst, medium purple (Quartz)

Mineralogy: dark violet crystal quartz (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) alertness, justice, inner peace (S) helps overcome grief and losses (M) awareness, sense of judgement, constructive thinking and acting (B) good for the skin; alleviates pain, tension and lowers high blood pressure.

Ametrine (Quartz)

Mineralogy: yellow/violet crystal quartz (trigonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) cheerful composure, a fulfilled existence (S) optimism, joie de vivre, feeling of well-being (M) helps retain creativity and dynamism in the face of all challenges (B) balances out body tension, harmonises the vegetative nervous system and body metabolism.

Rarity: scarce ○



Ammolite (Korite, Calcentine)

Mineralogy: ammonite shell made of Aragonite (orthorh., second.)

Indications: (SP) harmony, dignity, splendour (S) for sense of beauty, seductive charm, charisma (M) awakens interest in mysteries, releases mental obsessions (B) normalises cell metabolism, energy output, heartbeat and fortifies the heart.

Rarity: rare ○



Andalusite

Mineralogy: aluminium island silicate (orthorh., prim./tert.)

Indications: (SP) self-recognition, discovery of personal vocation (S) promotes self-confidence and generosity (M) helps to think big and be realistic at the same time (B) enhances de-acidification, good for stomach and intestine problems; has a strengthening effect.

Anhydrite (Angelite)

Mineralogy: anhydrous calcium sulphate (orthorhombic, secondary)

Indications: (SP) stability, stamina (S) helps withstand extreme psychic strain and overcome insecurity (M) ends fruitless brooding and helps give up obsessions (B) stimulates the kidney function, water balance and reduction of oedema.

Anthophyllite

Mineralogy: anthophyllite/staurolite rock (orthorhombic, tertiary)

Indications: (SP) self-esteem, acknowledgement (S) releases stress and self-created pressure (M) helps create and maintain room for personal interest (B) helps with nervous diseases as well as with problems of the kidneys and ears.

Bib.: [2] (see Hermanov Balls)

Rarity: scarce ○

Antimonite

Mineralogy: dark grey antimonite sulphide (orthorhombic, primary)

Indications: (SP) harmonises personal interests with higher ideals (S) helps give up negative habits (M) helps overcome limiting views (B) helps with problems of the digestive tract (stomach), gum and skin (peeling).

Apatite, blue

Mineralogy: blue calcium phosphate (hexagonal, mostly tertiary)

Indications: (SP) motivation (S) stabilises, helps combat listlessness after over-exertion (M) promotes independence and ambitiousness (B) builds up, de-acidifies and helps with rickets, arthrosis, osteoporosis and the healing of fractures.

Apatite, green

Mineralogy: green calcium phosphate (hexagonal, primary/tertiary)

Indications: (SP) sociable (S) livens up, helps combat listlessness after over-exertion (M) helps live life full of variety (B) builds up, de-acidifies, enhances formation of cartilage, bones and dentition, also helps with fractures.

Rarity: not always available ○



Apatite, yellow

Mineralogy: yellow calcium phosphate (hexagonal, mostly primary)

Indications: (SP) drive (S) makes extravert, invigorates and livens up, helps out of state of apathy (M) makes optimistic and hopeful (B) gives appetite; mobilises energy reserves; improves posture; helps with problems of the bones, cartilage and joints.

Rarity: scarce ○



Apophyllite, green

Mineralogy: water-containing sheet silicate (tetragonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) liberation, sincerity (S) helps with fear, pressure and feeling of oppression, releases withheld emotions (M) offers a moment of respite after great exertion (B) helps with problems of the nerves, skin and respiratory tract, allergies and asthma.

Rarity: scarce ○





Apophyllite, white

Mineralogy: water-containing sheet silicate (tetragonal, primary)

Indications: (SP) openness, frankness (S) helps overcome insecurity and openly show real nature (M) helps give up anxious tendencies and thought patterns (B) helps with problems of the skin, mucous membrane and respiratory tract, allergies and asthma.

Rarity: readily available ○



Aquamarine (Beryl)

Mineralogy: iron-containing beryl, blue to green (hexag., primary)

Indications: (SP) farsightedness, foresight (S) bestows perseverance, discipline, light heartedness (M) clears up confusion, helps to bring unfinished business to a conclusion (B) helps with allergies, hay fever, problems of the eyes, respiratory tract, thyroid gland and bladder.

Rarity: readily available ○



Aragonite, white

Mineralogy: white calcium carbonate (orthorhombic, secondary)

Indications: (SP) stable development (S) combats oversensitivity, stabilises exceedingly fast developments (M) promotes concentration, calms erratic behaviour (B) improves nervous spasms, strengthens muscles, bones, discs, immune system and improves digestion.

Aragonite-Calcite, banded

Mineralogy: calcium carbonate (orthorhombic/trigonal, secondary)

Mineralogy: iron aluminium island silicate (orthorhombic, tertiary)

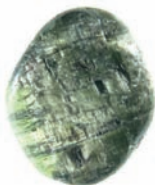

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Cairn Elen

After Elen had accomplished her wandering through the world, she placed a Cairn at the end of the Sarn Elen. Her path then led her back to the land between evening and morning. From this Cairn originated all stones that direct the way at crossroads up until today.¹

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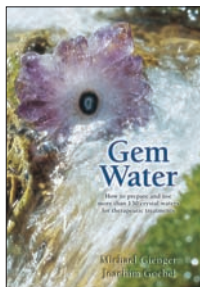
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¹Celtic 'cairn' [pronounced: carn] = 'Stone' (usually placed as an intentional shaped heap of stones), 'sarn' = 'Path', 'Elen, Helen' = 'Goddess of the Roads'

*Cairn Elen: in British ancient British culture, cairns are generally intentionally heaped piles of stones, rather than an individual stone such as a boulder or standing stone.

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
